I. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - There was no organized front line in the Div sector at the end of the period.
- Defensive organization - Mines were encountered on road and in fields vicinity K950850, 858843, 832828, and 853824. No organized defensive position was being encountered at end of period.
- Units in contact - Scattered elements of 183rd VG Div and 176th VG Div. Units identified thru PW's captured in the Div sector are listed as follows:

- Artillery - It is believed that the artillery of the 183rd Div and 176th Div have withdrawn to the NE. No battery locations were reported during period.

1. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention (Continued): -
the Div sector. The 17th SS Div and the 106th Pz Bde are available as reserves in the Corps sector.
2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:
- a. General summary - The enemy attempted to delay the advance of the Div with scattered small arms and mortar fire without an organized defensive position.
- b. Operations of component elements:
1. Artillery - A few rounds of artillery were reported vicinity BERGELN K8980 about 1000 this morning. And 2 or 3 rounds of nebelwerfer fire were reported vicinity OBERBRUCH K8874 about 2330 last night.
2. Infantry - Only very scattered resistance was encountered as our units advanced during the period.
3. MISCELLANEOUS:
- a. Estimated enemy casualties 100, 25 of which were killed and 75 long term wounded. No enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 250 PWs passed thru the Div cage during the period. Total for this operation 477. Grand total 12,885.
- c. Weather - Continued cloudy tonight and tomorrow with intermittent light rain during the period. Little change in temperature.
- d. Password - FADE reply FALTER from 011200 to 021200 March 1945.
