1. COUNTERINTELLIGENCE:

At BOTTROP A4427 arrested the following for Camp Q: Julius GUTHER, who performed duties of a Kreisleiter and Dienststelle for PSV; Bernhard FREUSNER, Ortsgruppenleiter; Gustav SCHIPPER, SA Sturmbannfuhrer; Alfred WEBER, company commander of SS police.

At GLADBECK A4831 arrested Fritz SCHWEERS, Ortsgruppenleiter Witte I, fled 28 March and returned 24 May, for Camp Q; Alexander JOSEPHS who admits to affiliations with Gestapo and is ardent Nazi; for Camp Q; Friedrich BARTCKS SA Sturmfuhrer and fanatical Nazi, for Camp Q; Franz SCHAUERTE SA Obersturmfuhrer, placed under house arrest for 14 days pending further investigation.

At RECKLINGHAUSEN A6336 arrested for Camp Q, Friedrich KUTBERG for acts of sabotage; Ernst WEISMANN Kreisratsleiter NSRB from 1936 to 1942 and Captain in Wehrmacht without any discharge papers.

A prisoner of war who was the chief scout of SS Army Scouts escaped from a camp near DAHRE Y1472. The prisoner, named Hans WOLBORS and of undetermined age, was dressed in a Wehrmacht uniform at the time of his escape. He is stockily built and has black hair. On 25 May one of our guards was fired on by a civilian in HEFERTH G9287. Investigation found neither arms nor ammunition in the town. At O530R a friendly patrol found a 20 yard section of wire around neck high stretched across the road near TREFFURT H7585. A patrol which traversed the same route at 252230R, detected no wire. VIII Corps reported that several wire lines leading to friendly outposts in the SCHWALKALDEN H9240 area were cut at 251800R. Several prisoners infiltrated into the 6th Cavalry Group area from the south in possession of improper discharge papers. Enemy soldiers at large in the area who have heard that discharges are being issued are turning themselves in at the cages. (See Ninth Army G-2 Per Rpt #264)

2. MISCELLANEOUS:

a. "T" Targets:

- How "T" Targets to be seized and safeguarded - none.
- "T" Target Schloss Fuchterf, Block No. B 28 released from intelligence classification but responsibility of guarding remains unchanged. (Target is presently located in 320th Inf area)

b. Miscellaneous - Members of Polish Underground movement captured by Germans and now freed will be treated as recovered Polish prisoners of war.

c. Weather - Generally low overcast during early morning with broken low clouds and intermittent rain throughout the day. Little change in temperature.
