1. COUNTERINTELLIGENCE:

On 26 and 27 May there were eight cases of wire cutting reported by the 79th Infantry Division. Seven of these incidents took place in the 314th area and one in the 313th area. All incidents are being investigated and necessary security measures enforced. (See: XVI Corps G-2 Per Rpt #112)

Enroute to his home in the Rhineland, an SS man was apprehended by the CIC at CCR. He told the story of having removed his SS uniform, putting on a Wehrmacht uniform, and surrendering to the Russians in Berlin. He was held but a few hours when they instructed him to get into civilian clothes and go home. It was interesting to note from his observations while in Russian territory the similarity to our own methods of operation. The Russians have a "Military Government established and announce their proclamations by public address system. They do not, however, have an extensive security plan set up. He heard of an organization which was arresting all Party Officials, Gestapo, etc. The work which would correspond to that performed by the CIC: Western Allied Displaced Persons are being moved as rapidly as possible toward the Elbe River. (See: 5th Armd Div thru VII Corps)

2. MISCELLANEOUS:

a. "T" Targets:

1. New "T" Targets to be seized and safeguarded - none.
2. "T" Targets to be released - none.

b. Miscellaneous - Classification of Messages: 1. Heretofore many messages originating in this theater have borne classification requiring encoding and decoding, which placed a tremendous burden upon communication facilities. 2. Since the cessation of hostilities in this theater, many messages of the type formerly transmitted in code and requiring a high classification can now be transmitted unclassified in the clear or their classification reduced to "Restricted." 3. All concerned are enjoined to analyze each message so information contained therein may be transmitted under the lowest possible classification.

c. Weather - Continued clear to partly cloudy throughout the day today, becoming increasingly cloudy late this afternoon.
