2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD (Continued):

b. Operations of component elements:

2. Artillery - Enemy continued to use SP fire and Nebelwerfers and most of the shelling reported is from single gun positions.
3. Chemical - Smoke was reported vicinity FUHRMAN FARM P613492 near end of period.
4. Infantry - Continued defensive action from positions as shown on overlay with an increased amount of small arms fire from the high ground in front of the 320th Inf near end of period. Strong enemy patrol (estimated 35 men) encountered 1,000 yards N of BAVIGNE near end of period.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 175, of which 150 were injured and 25 killed. 8 enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 116 PWs had passed thru Div cage since 1600. Total for this operation 339. Grand total 11,663.
- c. Weather - Continued cloudy tonight and tomorrow with intermittent snow and little change in temperature.
- d. Miscellaneous - See No Passage Line as shown on overlay.
- e. Password - BALTIMORE reply LORD from 041200 to 051200 January 1945.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
