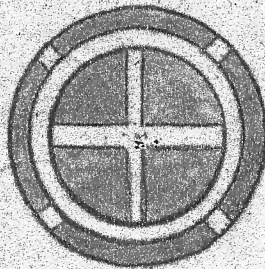

1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - At the end of period the Div was in contact with the enemy vicinity A108238, A0325, A0423, and A1120.
- Defensive organization - The Div is not in contact with an organized defensive position, although road blocks are reported at the following locations: A010256, A025233, A032228, A041227, A048225, A058224, A087220, and A066223.
- Units in contact - Units identified thru PWs clearing thru the Div cage during the period are listed as follows:

PWs from the miscellaneous units are listed as follows:

7th Para Div, 8th Para Div, GMJ Para Trng Bn, 55th Art Bn, 1506th Arty Bn, 1511th Fortress Arty Bn, 1521st Fortress Arty Bn, 39th Repl Trng Bn, 58th Repl Trng Bn, 77th Repl Trng Bn, 464th Repl Trng Bn, 276th Repl Trng Bn, and 356th Security Co.

- Artillery - Intense SP fire received at the end of period from vicinity A1024.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.
- Supply and Administrative Elements - Civilians and PWs report approximately 100 vehicles loaded with troops yesterday vicinity A1024, and believe these vehicles moved N thru or to ISSUM A0927.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Enemy vigorously defended with small arms, mortar and SP fire E of SEVELEN A0922, and delayed our movement to the N with numerous road blocks and mines.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Intensive SP fire fell in SEVELEN during the latter part of the period, and scattered artillery fire was reported falling in VENLO E9109 and NIEUKERK A0518.
 - Infantry - Intense small arms, automatic weapons and mortar fire was received from positions to the E and NE of SEVELEN during the period. Intense small arms fire also was reported vicinity GELDERN A0125.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 100, 25 of which were killed and 75 long term wounded. 5 enemy dead buried.
- Prisoners - 281 PWs passed thru Div cage during the period. Total for this operation 1,378. Grand total 13,786.
- Weather - Overcast tomorrow morning with broken clouds in the afternoon. Little change in temperature.
- Password - HAVE reply PAN from 041200 to 051200 March 1945.
