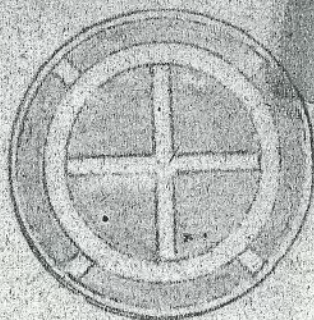

1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - The units of the Div were not in contact with an organized defensive position at end of period, but enemy was attempting to delay our advance by automatic weapons fire at scattered locations.
- c. Units in contact - Div was in contact with the 2nd and 23rd Para Regt of the 2nd Para Div; elements of the 1225th Regt and 1226th Regt of the 190th Inf Div; and elements of 4th AA Div. Locations of units identified thru PWs are listed as follows:

PWs from 44th, 64th and 74th Regts were taken at scattered locations of Div sector.

- d. Artillery - Scattered artillery fire was received on the forward elements early this morning. It is believed that much of this artillery came from dual purpose AA guns of caliber 128mm. See overlay.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy attempted to delay our advance with small arms fire and sporadic artillery fire on the forward elements.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Armor - Six enemy tanks were reported vicinity A526345 about 0630 this morning - these tanks went to the NE and S.
 2. Artillery - Sporadic artillery fire fell on the forward elements during the period.
 3. Infantry - Attempted to delay our advance with small arms fire and mortar fire on the forward elements.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Prisoners - 245 PWs passed thru Div cpg since 1800 yesterday. Total for operation 946. Grand total 18,083. Four enemy dead buried.
- b. Estimated enemy casualties 150, 35 of which were killed and 115 long term wounded.
- c. Weather - Intermittent showers during the night. Early morning fog until noon becoming broken to clear late in period with scattered clouds.
- d. Password - POOL reply CUE from 311200 March to 011200 April 1945.
