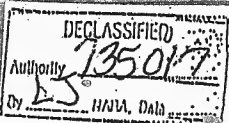

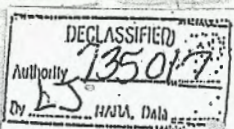

BULLETIN NO. 81. Intelligence Exploitation of German Personnel.

a. Field Information Agency, Technical (FIAT) has been established by higher Headquarters and will control and coordinate the intelligence exploitation of German personnel of interest to Scientific, Technological, Industrial, Economic and Financial agencies. This will include:-

(1) Exercising Intelligence Control over the detention camp known as DUSTBIN. (See Item 2).

(2) Controlling the movement of all German personnel in categories described above who are required to be moved for intelligence exploitation whether to DUSTBIN or elsewhere.

(3) Operating Intelligence and Records sections covering German personalities likely to be of interest to Scientific, Technological, Industrial, Economic and Financial agencies.

(4) Coordinating the collection and dissemination of the results of Intelligence exploitations of persons in the categories described above which are carried out by various agencies.

(5) Clearing with Counter-Intelligence that personnel are not required for CI purposes.

b. In order that the above responsibilities may be carried out, all agencies will:-

(1) Apply to FIAT, through AC of S, G-2, this Headquarters, for clearance whenever they wish to move personnel in the categories described in paragraph a. above for intelligence exploitation whether to DUSTBIN or elsewhere. Such personnel will not be moved without FIAT clearances.

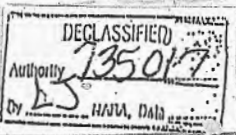
(2) Insure that a copy of all communications, letters, reports, etc., pertaining to the intelligence exploitation of German personnel in that category described in paragraph a. above be sent to FIAT.

c. All agencies now holding German personnel who fall within the categories described in paragraph a. above, will forthwith communicate full details concerning such personnel to FIAT, through AC of S, G-2, this Headquarters, who will take the necessary action for transferring them to DUSTBIN or making any other dispositions as may be necessary.

d. The provisions of this letter do not alter existing directives pertaining to the arrest, detention, movement and exploitation of German prisoners of war or persons of interest to Counter-Intelligence.

2. Special Detention Camp DUSTBIN.

This camp is at present located at KRANSBERG, FRANKFURT area.

The purpose of the camp is to provide a center where a limited number of enemy personnel of interest to Scientific, Technological, Industrial, Economic and Financial agencies may be detained while they are being exploited.

Agencies who wish to have individuals moved to DUSTBIN for exploitation must apply to the Field Information Agency, Technical, through AC of S, G-2, this Headquarters, giving as many of the following particulars as possible:-

- a. Full and exact name, including Christian names, of the man required.
- b. His age.
- c. His rank or title (e.g. Professor, Dr.)
- d. His appointment, or the office or institution with which he is connected.
- e. His home and business addresses.
- f. Any other information such as past record, SS membership, etc.
- g. A general statement of the reasons for the exploitation.
- h. The names of the personnel who will be exploiting and the address at which they can be contacted.
- i. Particulars of any other agencies concerned in the proposed exploitation.

The agency initiating the request must be prepared to send an officer to escort the prisoner from his present location to DUSTBIN and to provide an escort to return him there when the exploitation is completed.

Intelligence agencies who wish to interrogate personnel who are detained in DUSTBIN must apply to FIAT who will issue a pass giving authority to interrogate personnel. No agency will be admitted without such a pass. Agencies should provide their own stenographic assistance and German speaking interrogators, since only a limited number of interpreters are available at this camp.

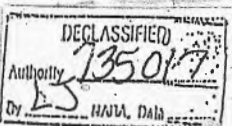
3. Traitors of American Citizenship.

The Department of Justice wishes to obtain any information that the Army may have indicating that these individuals are guilty of treason, including information concerning any assumption of German nationality, and the names and addresses of at least two witnesses to overt acts of broadcasting. It also would like to be notified should the Army arrest any other American citizens alleged to have given aid and comfort to the enemy acting as propaganda broadcasters, and to be furnished available information as a basis for indictments.

Request that any information you have or obtain on the above subjects be forwarded to AC of S, G-2, this Headquarters.

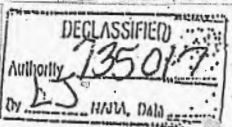

Subject is reported to have been in the employ of a US Army unit in the DUESSELDORF Area.

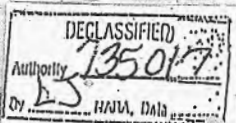
It is requested that, if apprehended, subject be turned over to the Belgian authorities.

"On 24 April, Wehrmacht Officer OBERLEUTNANT FRITZ KLEIN, who had formerly been an HJ Fuehrer, came to BRAUN's home in FREISING and demanded that BRAUN prepare false papers for himself and one OBERLEUTNANT RIEVER alias RUEFFER. KLEIN and RIEVER were in possession of 1,000,000 marks and instructions from high Party headquarters to form a post-war resistance organization in the RHEIN-PFALZ Area. KLEIN, who is now believed to be in LUDWIGSHAVEN, is 26 years old, of stout build, 5 ft 6 in tall, has very white teeth; his left arm has been amputated between the wrist and elbow."

MAJOR BRAUN states that he did not supply the false papers requested.

i. Request information on whereabouts of DOCTOR LUITPOLD WERZ, German National, who worked in Portuguese East Africa during war for German Intelligence Service. Description: 37 years of age, large build, blond hair, grey eyes, oval face, consul by profession, born in BERNE, SWITZERLAND.

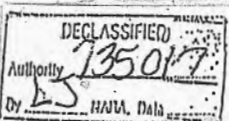

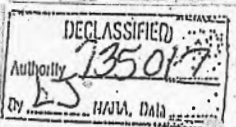
