1. ENEMY SITUATION AT- END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - Patrols encountered road blocks at K906734 and trenches located on roads SW out of OBERBRUCH K8874 and on road from FORSELEN K9072 to BLECKDEN K9073. Civilians report wooden bunkers between K869834 and 875816 also from K883775 to 886771. See overlay.
- c. Units in contact - Elements of 183rd VG Div and 176th VG Div as shown on overlay.
- d. Artillery - Civilians report four artillery positions, caliber unknown, at K887794 on 25 January.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - There is still no report of contact of the 116th Pz Div, 130th Pz Lehr Div and 3rd VG Div which may be employed as reserves in our sector.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continues to be on the defensive in our sector employing counter-patrol activity during the hours of darkness.
- b. Operations of component elements:
  1. Aviation - One enemy plane reported flying from SE to NW vicinity KEMPEN K8578 about 1500 this afternoon.
  2. Engineers - Our patrols encountered mine fields on road N of FORSELEN K9072 and along road S of OBERBRUCH K8874. Civilians report additional mines at K845805, on road between HEINSBERG K8575 to KEMPEN K8578, K835772, 856787, 823782 and on road from 837810 to 841801.
  3. Infantry - Scattered mortar fire fell in DREMMEN K8872 about 1400. A ten man enemy patrol encountered vicinity FORSELEN about 0330 last night. MG was firing last night 100 yards N of THEERATH K8577. 8 man enemy patrol contacted at 1420 vicinity K893738.
  4. Miscellaneous - Enemy employed counter-patrol activities last night with frequent white and yellow flares near our forward elements.

### 3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Weather - Cloudy tonight and tomorrow with scattered showers tomorrow. Little change in temperature.
- b. Miscellaneous - No Passage Line is located as follows: 863644, 866642, 864658, 866683, 834699, 778729, 782741 and 776758.
- c. Password - WATERED reply WHISKEY from 071200 to 081200 February 1945.
