**1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:**

- Enemy front line - No change.
- Defensive organization - Friendly patrols last night encountered additional road blocks and mines on road N of RIECKEN K9073.
- Units in contact - Elements of 183rd VG Div and 176th VC Div.
- Artillery - No new artillery positions reported.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - 116th Pz Div (OR estimates 4,000 men and 25 tanks), 130th Pz Lehr Div (OR estimates 2,500 men and 25 tanks) and 3rd VG Div (OR estimates 3,500 men with 20 tanks) are available as reserves in the Div sector.

**2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:**

- General summary - Attitude of the enemy continues to be defensive in our sector with active enemy patrolling during the hours of daylight and counter-patrol activity during the hours of darkness.
- Operations of component elements:
  - Artillery - Eight rounds of artillery (Est 75mm) fell at K868738 about 2340 last night, and 4 rounds of artillery (Est 105mm) fell at K862731 about 1145 today.
  - Infantry - Enemy patrols were encountered last night in strength and locations as follows: 15 man patrol vicinity K847774 about 2200, 15 man enemy patrol vicinity K873743 about 2215, and vicinity OBERBRUCH K8874 about 2215. Small groups of enemy were reported by our daylight patrols and OPs vicinity K872757, 895739, 897753 (Approximately 40 men observed at this last location about 1355), and vicinity WERLOH K837782.
  - Miscellaneous - Numerous flares were reported last night on our forward elements. Buildings were observed burning in K8578 about 2115 last night. Approximately 35 civilians came into our lines from WERLOH and THERERATH K852772 about 1500 this afternoon.

**3. MISCELLANEOUS:**

- Six enemy dead buried.
- Weather - Continued cloudy with scattered showers tonight and tomorrow with little change in temperature.
- Password - ROSE reply BED from 081200 to 091200 February 1945.
