WANTED PERSONS

WAR CRIMINALS

SCHNITZ, Friedrich - German civilian wanted for murder of an American aviator.

Description: - Age: about 53; height: 5'6" (1.67m); weight: 140 lbs; hair dark blond (bald spot on top of head); eyes: brown; complexion: ruddy; face: thin; build: slender; deformities: lower two joints of little finger, right hand, missing. Alleged to have been wounded in right foot by shrapnel. Reportedly resided at house number 197 in "ETTERDORF".

Wanted by Judge Advocate, Hq Fifteenth US Army.

SCHNEIDER, Dr Erich - Worked at Lunatic Asylum (Landesheilanstalt) in WEIL-
"UESEN". Knows all details and has records pertaining to "mercy killings of
2000 lunatics" in 1941 at HADAMAR (G20) asylum near WIESBADEN (W36). Wanted
by Third US Army.

BERNOTAT, Landrat - Ordered execution of "lunatics". Home is in WIESBADEN (W36);
has hunting lodge at WEIL"UESEN" (G40). Wanted by Third US Army.

WIEGAND, Dr/Frau - Has knowledge of details of executions of "lunatics".
Worked at Lunatic Asylum EICHBERG (U83). Is niece of Gauleiter KAUFMANN of
HAMBURG and confidant of BERNOTAT. Wanted by Third US Army.

WILLINSKY, Erich - Member of SA. Concerned in slaying of four Allied airmen.

Description: - Age: 45-50 yrs; black hair; slightly grey; height: about
6'; erect carriage; hazel eyes; large, hooked nose; gold tooth, hair
usually combed back with a part.

WITTE (FNU) - Member of SA. Involved in slaying with WILLINSKY.

Description: - Age: 36; height: 5'8"; hair: bald, blond fringes; eyes:
blue; small scar on face.

SECURITY THREATS

PIERER, Walter - Obergefreiter. German, born in ST VITH. V/T operator of AET
BRUSSELS, later with Trupp 123 of Kommando 130 in BRUSSELS (Aug 1944). In
BAD NEUENAU until end of Feb 1945.

Description: - Age 24-25 yrs; height: 1.63m; weight: 176 lbs; build:
corpulent; face, round; nose, normal; complexion, red; hair, dark blond;
eyes, brown; mis. medical student. Speaks French, Flemish, and Walloon
fluently, as well as good English. Wore Wehrmacht uniform with Signal
Corps insignia.

JANSEN, Quirin - Former Oberburgermeister of AACHEN and SS Standartenfuhrer
(Colonel). Ordered certain records and money of AACHEN to be removed and took
a million and a half RM belonging to AACHEN during two-week period preceding
13 May before departing. He was also suspected of absconding with Nazi Party
funds before 1933.

Description: - Age, 56 yrs; height, 5'10"; figure, stout; hair, almost
bald; eyes, dark, wears horn-rimmed glasses, bags under eyes, lips,
thick; one or two fingers on right hand missing. Strong AACHEN dialect,
often drunk.

SECURITY THREATS (Continued)

WIESHENSEE (fnu) - Kriminalkomissar, head of Sec IV 1 CW of ESSEN Gestapo for suppression of resistance movements; allegedly present during execution of Polish and Russian forced labor workers in Feb 1945. (HENZE and BOVENSIEPEN-4 and 5 below.

Description: - Age, 40 yrs; height 5'6"; figure, slim; face, small and regular; fair, black and balding; eyes, brown.

HENZE, Max - Formerly police Chief of ESSEN

BOVENSIEPEN, Gunther - Kriminalkomissar of Section IV 1 CR/P/A Supervision, of all Russian and Polish workers and foreigners of the ESSEN Gestapo.

SCHMIDT, Johann - Age 65; Amtsleiter, Kreis Ahrweiler; probably hiding somewhere in Germany west of the Rhine.

SZEREMET, Harry - Civilian; claims to be a German from BERLIN; escaped from a truck at GRUMBACH (L7515) while being transported by MG.

Description: - Age 25 yrs; height, 5'8"; weight, 175 lbs; hair, blond, bushy; wearing brown coat and dark brown trousers.

DECKER, Leo - French civilian; home at STEINBIEDERSDORF (PONT PIERRE) Q2049. Escaped from a truck at BRUMBACH L7515 while being transported by MG.

Description: - Age, 23 yrs; height, 5'8"; weight, 158 lbs; complexion, dark; wearing blue coat.

RESEKOW, Arno, Hauptsturmfuehrer u. Assessor - Responsible for all sabotage operations involving sending agents to foreign countries; head of the department known as Amt VI/S-2. May be PW.

Description: - Age, 34; height, 5'10"; weight, 190 lbs; build, athletic; very light eyes; brown hair, brushed back with plenty of brilliantine; no moustache; joined Schuetzkorps Alpenland, Kaerntner Group. Was at RAHSTATT the last half of April, according to SKORZENY. Wanted by 12th Army Group.

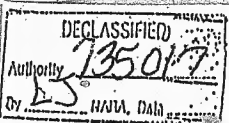
GERHARD, Reinhard (or Reinhold) Hauptsturmfuehrer - SKORZENY's expert on sabotage equipment, I/b of Amt VI/S Fuehrungsstab (literally, Supply Officer of the German Sabotage Service's Headquarters Staff).

Description: - Age 33; height 5'10"; very slim; small head and neck; darkish-blond hair; many wounds and scars on hands and face from grenade splinters; typical bearing of a Prussian General Staff Officer. May have gone to the Oder Front 15/25 April. Wanted by 12th Army Group.

WINTER, Heinz Hauptsturmfuehrer u. Kriminalrat - Senior sabotage instructor of the NEU-STRELITZ Sabotage School, known as Kampfschule NEU-STRELITZ. Technically on the Staff of Jagdverband Nordwest. Reported by captured saboteurs to have lectured on poisons, among other things.

Description: - Age 37; height, 5'10"; weight 165 lbs; dark hair, bald on top; light colored eyes; no moustache; thin, long, pale face; last seen at the end of April at PUCH near SALZBURG. Joined Schuetzkorps Alpenland, Kaerntner Group. On 17 May, SKORZENY said that, as far as he knew, WINTER was at MAUTERNDORF waiting to surrender. He may be in PW channels. Wanted by 12th Army Group.

WIRTH, Wolfgang - Prof. Dr. Med Pharmacologist and toxicologist. Military Rank: Oberstarzt. Member of Abteilung fur Wissenschaft u. SCHURANN, Paul - Prof. Dr. Med Pathologist. Military Rank: Oberfeldarzt and Commandant of Lehrgruppe C (Research) of Military Medical Academy. Director of Lehrgruppe C (Research of Military Medical Academy; Director of Institute of Pathology of Military Medical Academy. Last address; Militararztliche Akademie, Berlin, N.W. 40 Scharnhorststrasse 35. Berlin-Charlottenburg, Reichstrasse 9.

SCHREIBER, (FNU) - Prof. Dr. Med. Military Rank: Generalarzt. Director of Abteilung fur Wissenschaft und Gesundheitsforschung of the Military Medical Academy. Last address: Militararztliche Akademie Berlin, N.W. 40 Scharnhorststrasse 35.

HEERLEIS, Dr. (FNU) - Design engineer at Krupp plant in ESSEN: thought to be in or around that city. Wanted by 12th Army Gp, Major Kaufman, Eagle 8721.
ESZHER, (FNU) - Assistant to HEERLEIS; same locality. Wanted by 12th Army Gp.
VON WINTERWELD (FNU) - President of Siemens, France. Wanted by 15th US Army (SC1).

It is desired that the 11 personalities listed above be held in place pending advice from 12th Army Gp Hq. They are wanted for interrogation by the UNITED STATES STRATEGIC BOMBING SURVEY.

GESTAPO AGENTS AND OFFICIALS

The following wanted list is a compilation of statements made by Polish Displaced Persons. These wanted individuals may have entered the Fifteenth Army District in an attempt to go underground.

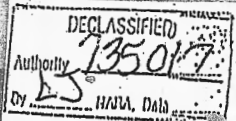
NOLFRAM, Edmund - A Gestapo agent. House owner in WARSAW, 5 Wysogrodzki St.
Description: - Age 21; height about 1.65m; face, oblong; long nose; hair blond.

SALAMON, Josef - Before the war he was in POLAND as a police agent; after the Germans came he started to work for the German police. Lived in WARSAW/
PELCOWIZNA, 6 Jablonkowska Str.

MIELKE, Edmund - Gestapo official. Lived in WARSAW/MOKOTOW, Litewska Str, where had 3 rooms and a kitchen.

Description: - Age 36-40; medium height.

WILTSCH (FNU) - Former agent of the Polish Secret Police. During the German occupation he became a German police agent.
Description: - Age, about 30; height medium; face oval; hair dark blond; lived in PIAS.

CONFIDENTIALGESTAPO AGENTS AND OFFICIALS (Continued)

SCHREIBER (FNU) - Former police inspector in Dabrowa Cornica.

Description: - Age 47-50; hair dark; height, 1.75-1.80m; always dressed in civilian clothes.

LIPKA, Robert - Member of the German Intelligence Service.

Description: - Age 46; height 1.65-1.70m; hair blond; before the war he lived in NAKLO (Poland), at present in HERNE, WESTFALLEN.

ADLER, Peter - German Hauptwachtmeister in the prison in Brandenburg. Alleged to have tortured prisoners.

Description: - Tall; scar on forehead.

MEZYNSKI (FNU) - Signed the Volksdeutsche list and collaborated with the Gestapo. Lived in POZNAN, Marshal Foch Str.

GORKA or GORKI, Jan - Collaborated with the Germans. Lived in NOWY SĄCZ, Jagielonska Str. 11.

KELLER (FNU) - Gestapo official in LODZ.

Description: - Age 32, figure thin; tall; face, lean.

FISCHER, Karl - SS man. Commanded Group of Germans in civilian clothes, engaged in espionage activity against Poles.

Description: - Age about 44; hair, dark.

POMER, Rudolf - Gestapo Official. Lived in LODZ, Zgodna Str 28.

WEISS, Otto - German policeman. Caused many Poles to be put in concentration camps.

Description: - Age about 30; height 1.80m; figure, fat; hair, brown; lived in LODZ, Tatrzenska Str 20.

WERNER, Josef - Gestapo Agent.

Description: - Age about 40; hair, brown; tall; lived in LODZ.

HUPNER, Johann - Gestapo Agent.

Description - Age about 30; height, medium; hair, dark blond; eyes, gray; working in Gestapo camp in LODZ.

KRAUZE, (FNU) - Woman. Chief of Gestapo camps for women in Sikawa - LODZ. Allegedly tortured Polish women.

STEIN, Franz - Member of SS Galizien. Gave Poles to the Gestapo. Lived in ~~DMOW~~, Krakowska Str 10.

Description: - Height, medium; hair, dark; eyes, dark; gold tooth in upper part of mouth; in 1943 he was in Coblenz working for the Gestapo.

KUPPER (FNU) - Gestapo agent. Baltic German.

Description: - Age about 40; hair, dark; living in LODZ, 1st May Str 35.

GUMPERT, Josef - Observed in Gestapo uniform.

Description: - Age about 40; hair, somewhat bald; tall; figure, fat, lived in AUGSBURG.

WAGNER, (FNU) - Gestapo official.

Description - Age, about 40, tall; figure, fat; hair, blond, somewhat bald; lived in AUGSBURG near Markthalle.

STEINER (FNU) - Gestapo official.

Description: - Age, about 40; tall; face, slim; hair, blond; lived in AUGSBURG.

Description: - Build, medium; hair, dark; wounded in head; moustache; German infantry uniform; next of kin, Dr. SEIBT; address, LENGDORF, OBERBAYERN.

HUBERT, Wewer Feldwebel - Late of Heeresnachsichub Truppen Schule, HANNOVER. Absentee from hospital in the NEUENKIRCHEN Group.

Description: - Height, medium; hair grizzled; heart weakness; German infantry uniform; next of kin, IISE WEWER, address, RAYENTHAL-GURTEL, COLOGNE.

RAVENSWAY (FNU) - SS Trooper.

Description: - Height, 5'7"; hair, blond; eyes, blue or grey blue; jacket and trousers; SS stamped on back of jacket; may have discarded jacket; wearing shoes; walks with stoop; bends arm like ape. Wanted by Provost Marshal, 21 Army Gp
