### 1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - See overlay.
- Defensive organization - Enemy strong point was located vicinity VILLERS P573502. See overlay for additional defensive positions.
- Units in contact - See overlay. Contact thru PWs in the last three days are listed as follows:

- Artillery - New hostile battery was located vicinity P58465345 - see overlay.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - 1st SS Div is believed available as immediate reserve in our sector.
- Supply and Administrative Elements - See overlay for reported CP locations.

### 2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Enemy strongly defended with small arms, MG, mortar fire, a moderate amount of artillery fire on our forward elements.
- Operations of component elements:
  - Artillery - Intermittent artillery was reported on the forward elements during the period with small concentrations reported vicinity P572497 and 559475.
  - Infantry - Continued strong defensive action from positions shown on overlay with small arms, MG and mortar fire. Strong point was contacted vicinity VILLERS.
  - Miscellaneous - 6th Armd reports enemy tanks, SP guns and troops in vehicles observed on road S of WARDIN P6056 at 1100.

### 3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 200, of which 175 were injured and 25 killed. 2 enemy dead buried.
- Prisoners - 5 PWs had passed thru Div cage since 081600. Total for this operation 629. Grand total 11,963.
- Weather - Continued cloudy to partly cloudy throughout period with scattered snow showers, but somewhat clearer late tomorrow morning, with little change in temperature.
- Miscellaneous - Units are to forward immediately identifications noted on any enemy tanks contacted and advise this Headquarters immediately of captured or killed tank crewmen.
- Password - DRIVER reply BRASSIE from 101200 to 111200 January 1945.

### 4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
