## 1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - No change.
- Defensive organization - See 1/25,000 defensive overprinted maps as of 01 February 1945. See ROER RIVER photo map (Uncontrolled) 1/12,500, with the defensive positions overprinted on the photo map. See mine map overlay attached. Patrols last night encountered strong point vicinity HILFARTH K9372 - see overlay.
- Units in contact - See Order of Battle Estimate attached to this report.
- Artillery - Artillery fire was received early in the period from SP guns on the E side of the ROER RIVER.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - See Order of Battle Estimate attached.

## 2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Enemy continued defensive action with strong counter-patrol activity by day and night with some scattered artillery and mortar fire.
- Operations of component elements:
  - Artillery - Enemy artillery activity decreased during the period. Twelve rounds of 105mm fell vicinity K8277 about 2100; 12 rounds, estimated 105mm, fell vicinity K8469 about 1800 yesterday; and 7 rounds, estimated 105mm, fell K853732 about 1800 yesterday.
  - Aviation - One FW-190, flying NE, vicinity K8768 was observed at 0915, no bombing or strafing was reported.
  - Infantry - Continued defensive action with flares during the night and strong OPs V of the ROER RIVER manned both day and night. Our patrols encountered strong points and intense small arms and mortar fire from vicinity K931724 and K935718.
  - Miscellaneous - Friendly liaison planes were subjected to accurate small arms fire and 20mm fire from positions on both sides of the ROER RIVER.

## 3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Weather - Partly cloudy to clear tomorrow morning but becoming cloudy with rain later in the day. Cooler temperatures tomorrow with freezing temperature during the night of 10-11 February.
- Password - CAESAR reply GHOST from 101200 to 111200 February 1945.

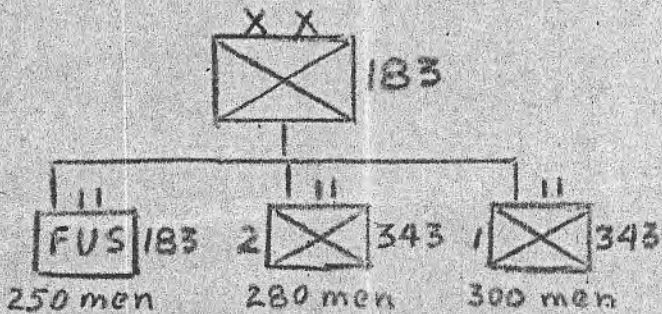

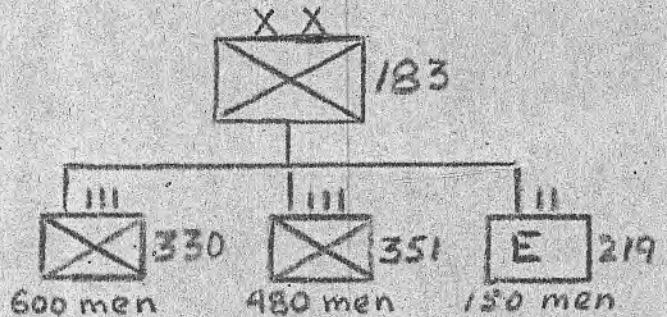
ORDER OF BATTLE ESTIMATE

TOTAL: 830 MEN?

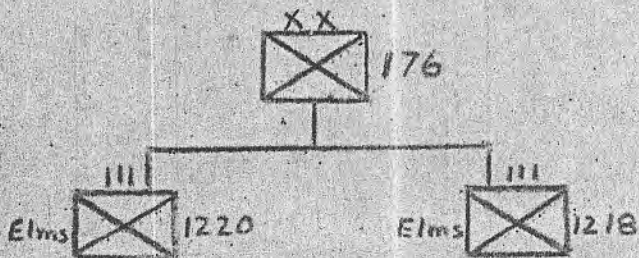
IMMED. RESERVE



TOTAL: 1230 MEN?

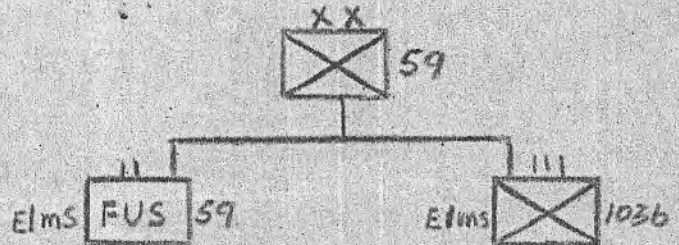
ENEMY UNITS ON

(S TO N)



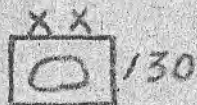
1300 MEN?
