1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

Division was not in contact with enemy during the period.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:
The units of the Division continued to guard security targets and arrest individuals classified as security threats.

An American soldier driving a 1/4 ton vehicle (35-216F on bumper) was stopped by 2 men and shot 5 times in the stomach and the vehicle taken about 1300 this afternoon vicinity HOHNSTEDT C5353. The 2 men who spoke perfect English are described as follows: The 1st man wore GI clothing and a helmet liner and a jacket with staff sergeant chevrons on it, he was armed with a Carbine and carried binoculars, height approximately 5'7" and weighed 165 pounds. The 2nd man wore GI trousers, a blue shirt and a British jacket, this man had sandy hair and blue eyes and was armed with a foreign made pistol. The 2 men drove the vehicle towards the W.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

a. Counterintelligence: -

Counterintelligence:-
"Don't move around alone at night in GERMANY. Don't loiter in unguarded, unlighted areas, and don't be beguiled off your path by the enemy. Smiling frauleins not only spell punishment for fraternization--they are also likely to be trap bait. Already the bodies of American soldiers who had been jumped from behind and choked to death have been found in rear areas."--Security Comdr, III Corps. This appeared in Battle Experiences No. 100, 5 May 1945.

At ISERNHAGEN X4033 arrested: Edward HOCHMUTH, SS untersturmfuhrer,

At VOLKSEN X2903 arrested Egon HILBURG, Gestapo watchman, accused of beating inmates of concentration lager in HANNOVER and suspected of being an SS Oberscharfuhrer, as a security threat. The chief of police at HANNOVER stated that he thought subject's papers were forged.

At WULFEL X3916 arrested Jean RELEVILLE, French, Waffen SS

b. Miscellaneous - PWs in civilian clothes will not be picked up unless they belong to the automatic arrest category.
