1. By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, the Purple Heart is awarded to:

Technician Fifth Grade Wayne H. Johnson (Army Serial No 31115425), Tank Destroyer Forces, United States Army, for wounds received as a result of enemy action on 21 September 1944, in France. Entered military service from Vermont.

2. By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, an Oak Leaf Cluster, for wear with the Purple Heart previously awarded, is awarded to:

Sergeant John J. Drtlieb (Army Serial No 93475006), Infantry, United States Army, for wounds received as a result of enemy action on 15 September 1944, in France. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.
