AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President, under the provisions of Circular 6, Headquarters Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

Chaplain (Captain) JOHN S. HAYES, 0539083, Chaplains Corps, Headquarters \* \* \* Field Artillery Group, United States Army, for heroic service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States, in France, from 8 November 1944 to 8 December 1944. Chaplain HAYES voluntarily and with disregard for personal safety, entered the areas under enemy shell fire where he gave spiritual comfort to the wounded and frequently assisted in rendering first aid. His prompt arrival in the battery positions receiving enemy shell fire, and his exemplary conduct were an inspiration to all and contributed materially to their calm and efficient functioning. The courage and heroic devotion to duty displayed repeatedly by Chaplain HAYES exemplify his great personal qualities and is in keeping with the highest traditions of the Chaplains Corps.
