I - AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President and under the provisions of Circular 6, Headquarters Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star Medal, for heroic achievement in connection with military operations against an armed enemy, is awarded to:

Private First Class JAMES E. KALEY, 35692925, Field Artillery, Battery B, * * * Armored Field Artillery Battalion, Army of the United States. On 15 December 1944, about one mile east of * * * , France, Private First Class KALEY obtained the necessary data for preparation of a shelling report. To obtain the data, he entered an area that the enemy had been shelling continuously. Unhesitatingly and willingly he proceeded into the danger zone being fully aware of the fact that any point in the area might be shelled again at any time, and, with complete disregard for his own safety, completed the mission of obtaining valuable information for use in counter-battery fire. Private First Class KALEY's devotion to duty, in spite of the personal hazards involved, reflects considerable credit upon him, and is in keeping with the highest traditions of the armed forces of the United States.

II - AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President and under the provisions of Circular 6, Headquarters Third United States Army, 26 April 1944, the Bronze Star Medal, for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an armed enemy during the respective periods indicated, is awarded to:

Sergeant EDCILE R. COVEY, 35645756, Field Artillery, Battery B, * * * Armored Field Artillery Battalion, Army of the United States, 25 November 1944 to 26 December 1944.

Technician Fifth Grade HAROLD R. BYERS, 35579153, Field Artillery, Battery A, * * * Armored Field Artillery Battalion, Army of the United States, 19 August 1944 to 24 December 1944.

Private First Class ARTHUR O. MARTIN, 35661859, Field Artillery, Battery B, * * * Armored Field Artillery Battalion, Army of the United States, 1 September 1944 to 24 December 1944.

III - AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL (OAK-LEAF CLUSTER)


