Pursuant to authority contained in AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, and Weekly Directive No. 38, Hq AGF, dated 18 September 1945, a Purple Heart is awarded to Colonel William S. Murray, O-12 227, Infantry, 137th Infantry, for wounds received in action against the enemy on 8 November, 1944, at Allaucourt, France. Entered the U S Military Academy from New Mexico.
