I --- BRONZE STAR MEDAL (OAK LEAF CLUSTER). Pursuant to authority contained in AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, and Weekly Directive No. 38, Hq AGF, dated 18 September 1945, in addition to the Bronze Star Medal previously awarded, a bronze Oak-Leaf Cluster is awarded to Captain Lyale I. Abbott, O-411757, Infantry, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in Central France, Belgium, Luxembourg, Holland and Germany during the period 26 August 1944 to 1 May 1945. Entered the military service from Nebraska.

II --- PURPLE HEART. Pursuant to authority contained in AR 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, and Weekly Directive No. 38, Hq AGF, dated 18 September 1945, the Purple Heart is awarded to the following-named officers and enlisted men for wounds received in action against the enemy on dates and in countries indicated:
