I --- BRONZE STAR MEDAL. Pursuant to authority contained in AR 600-45 dated 22 September 1943, as amended, and Weekly Directive No. 38, Hq Army Ground Forces, dated 18 September 1945, a Bronze Star Medal is awarded to Master Sergeant John H. Chapman, 16 174 377, Infantry, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States in France, Belgium, Holland, Luxembourg and Germany during the period 7 January 1945 to 9 May 1945. Entered the military service from Illinois.

II --- PURPLE HEART. Pursuant to authority contained in AR 600-45 dated 22 September 1945, as amended, and Weekly Directive No. 38, Hq Army Ground Forces, dated 18 September 1945, the Purple Heart is awarded to the following named officers and enlisted men for wounds received in action against the enemy on dates and in countries indicated:
