

TACTICAL INTERROGATION REPORT
IPW TEAM 60-B, 134TH INFANTRY

PW were captured yesterday evening at 2000 by our 1st Bn. The 2nd Co was dug in a defensive position yesterday in a ravine north of Fossieux. These men went to the rear to find themselves some hot food, because they had had no hot chew for the last three days. When they returned to their position the company was gone and the two men gave themselves up to Americans.

PW state that their company arrived in 5 trucks, three days ago, from a position at the Moselle some 60 km away. They were 80 men then, but the strength at present is around 60 men. Their CO is 1st Lt Wien. Previously the Regt had been engaged at Thionville, 30 km north of Metz, and had suffered high casualties. PW state ~~XXXX~~ that the 2nd Bn was practically wiped out there.

PW say their unit moved about so much lately they can't remember the route they have taken. They are also completely ignorant of the situation in this sector.

PW don't know of any other unit of their Regt in this sector.
