

TACTICAL INTERROGATION REPORT
IPW TEAM 60-B, 134TH INFANTRY

14 Oct 44

Hermann Behre, Pfc, 8th Co, 1125th Regt, 559th Div. Deserter.

PW states that the 8th Co is located in hedges at coordinates 029273 and has 4 heavy MG there. The strength of the 8th Co is 80 men combat strength. Russian prisoners are used in the supply trains. The 5th Co is to the right of the 8th and along the southern right corner of the wood La Jurée and has only 20 men.

The 8th Co CP and the 2nd Bn CP are located in two World War I pill boxes in row of hedges at 035283. Along these hedges are also 4 80mm mortars. PW states that during his flight he saw 2 75mm AT guns move in direction of the wood la Jurée.

Two 120mm mortars of the 8th Co are in position 039290.

Four infantry howitzers of the 13th Co are at 035293.

The prime movers of the inf howitzers are in Oriecourt.

The CP of the 1125th Regt is in the castle in the NE portion of Oriecourt, at coord 031305.

A Btry of 4 105mm how has its location at 029306.

PW knows of a btry of 88mm AA guns on both sides of road just north of Laneuveville. The trains of the 5th and 8th Cos are in Laneuveville. The kitchen vehicles and administrative sections are in Fonteny.

The 559th Div CP is in Morhange.

PW states that the Germans in this sector are building winter dugouts and material for this purpose is being brought up at present. The Germans believe that the Americans have only a lot of artillery here and not much infantry.
