3 PW from an Air Corps Trrg Bn (Ground troops mortar school)

This Trng Bn which originally had 120 mm mortars, lost them thru direct artillery hits at Luneville 14 days ago, and the companies have since become separated.

The 2nd Co of the Bn was in a rest area at Achatel, 10 km north of Fossieux. Yesterday one platoon of 30 men left Achatel on two trucks and at 5 o'clock in the afternoon dismounted in Fossieux. From here 6 men were sent out on two missions. One group of 3 men was to reconnoiter the area and the hill halfway between Fossieux and Malaucourt to see whether they were free of Americans. The second group went to Malaucourt itself to find out if Americans were there. This last group got captured.

The men from the Trng Bn were sent down here because of losses among infantry units in this area. They saw no armor on the way.
