Ist and 2nd Co II76 AT Bn I76 VG Div.

Strength: Ist Co has 75 men, 2nd 85.

Weapons: I st Co has 5 75mm gums and probably 3 more of the same type with
the newly resferred 3rd plateen.
2nd Co has 9 assault gums of Mark III tank type. PW was teld that 7 of
these 9 gums had to be blown up by their own crew during recent fighting
in the ERKELENZ area. The 2 nd Co has also 2 light English or
american tanks with 37 mm gums and three mgs. They had been captured
with plenty of ammunition at SCHNIERWALDENRATH (vic.WALDFEUCHT) in
Nevember. Some assaultgums were expected shortly.

PW from 5th Co, 1218th Regt reports that the 1219th was taken scmewhere to the north. The 1220th Regt is supposed to be being groomed for a ceuter attack. PW states that since October it has been a deliberate pelicy to send men who live in western Germany to that front for its defense, and men from eastern Germany to the eastern front, in the belief that these men will defend their home soil better.
