SUBJECT: Report of Activities prior to D-day

TO : Hq Mil Int Sw, European T of Opns, APO 887, U S Army.

- 1. This team was formed at Camp Ritchie, Md., in March 1944, left the U.S. on 7 Apr 44 and reported at FID ETOUSA (Breadws, England) about 17 Apr 44. Early in May 44 the team reported for duty with Hq. 35th Inf Div at Tavistock, England, where it remained until departure for France on 4 July 44.
- 2. Activities during this period consisted of the following types of training:
 - a. Acquiring preficiency in the use of the team's equipment.
 - b. Physical conditioning by marches and athletic games.
- e. One man was sent to attend the Order of Battle School and another the Decuments School at London.
- 3. Additional activities included:
- a. Testing the proficiency of men of all units of the division in speaking, reading and writing French and German.
- b. Lectures to the efficers of the 110 Medical Bn on the value of and the procedure for interrogation of FW, and the possible future relationship of the IPW Team and the division's medical services in regard to wounded prisoners.
- e. The presentation of a playlet demonstrating interregation of PW for the instruction of units of the division was prepared but not used because of lack of time.
