1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD

2. ENEMY ACTIVITY DURING PERIOD

a. General summary - 3rd Bn met heavy resistance during early part of period in their attack on hill 540 (5753). Enemy counter-attack at 0445 Dec 30th reported strength 400 to 500 men. So far as known at this time our units held firmly, but some enemy was able to infiltrate our lines.

b. Operation of component elements

(1) Artillery - some artillery fire was during early part of period. An increasing amount of fire was reported during the morning of the 30th.

(2) Aviation - 1st Bn reported one enemy plane bombed the town of Marvis at 0720.

(3) Infantry - enemy inf resisted the advance during early hours of period with small arms and mortar and Nebelwerfer fire. Enemy inf attacked during the morning of 30th and accomplished some infiltration of our lines.

(4) Tanks - it is believed that approx 30 enemy tanks were in the ~~ASSEMBLING~~ area in the vic North of Lutrebois. 4th Arm Div reports 11 of these tanks knocked out.

3. MISCELLANEOUS

- a. Estimated casualties - 100
- b. Prisoners - 8 PWs through cage during period
- c. CO 3rd Bn reports enemy attacking and infiltrating our lines were wearing American uniforms

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES * continue counter attack with possible 20 tanks and 2 Bns of 331st Regt not yet identified
