2. ENEMY ACTIVITY DURING THE PERIOD:

- a. General Summary: Enemy was active during entire period with small arms, Artillery, Nebelwerfer fire. 2nd Bn in adv on morning of 31 Dec met heavy resistance.
- b. Operations of Component elements:
 - (1) Artillery: Enemy artillery was active during period. Concentration fell at following locations - 5474 (548515). Nebelwerfer concentration fell throughout period over Regt 2.
 - (2) Inf: - 1st activity opened 1st Regt with all types small arms fire. Mortar fire was heavy throughout period on fwd positions. Extremely heavy mortar fire fell in vic of 1st Bn CP (555514).
 - (3) Tanks: - This Regt was opposed by tank fire throughout period. For reported tank locations at end of period - see overlay.

3. Miscellaneous:

- a. Estimated Casualties - 200
- b. Prisoners - 18 Pz passed through Regt 2 zone during the period.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES:

- a. Enemy can continue to resist advance of this Regiment from positions & concentrations as shown on overlay.
- b. Counterattack with troops concentrated in woods via (5753) and (5855). Much enemy activity has been observed in this locality.

1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD
 - a. Enemy front lines - see overlay
 - b. Units in contact with - 1 PW 5th Co 351 Regt 157 Div captured vic 560530.
 - c. Arty Pos - see overlay
 - d. Communication and supply - no change
2. ENEMY ACTIVITY DURING PERIOD
 - a. General summary - enemy was active during period. This Regt encountered S/A, Nebelwerfer, artillery and tank fire throughout period.
 - b. Operation of component elements
 - (1) Artillery - enemy arty was active throughout period. Sporadic fire fell throughout sector. Interdictory fire fell on fwd positions and roads during the night.
 - (2) Aviation - several unidentified planes were over Regt area during the night. 1 Ju 188 0353 hrs over area to the west.
 - (3) Infantry - P Co received a counter attack against their right flank at 311500 Dec 44. Was successfully repulsed. An enemy patrol attempted to infiltrate through P Co lines at 312000 Dec 44. Patrol was fired on, several members killed, and the remainder driven off.
 - (4) Tanks - as shown on overlay
3. MISCELLANEOUS
 - a. Estimated casualties - 150
 - b. Prisoners - 1 PW passed through cage during period
 - c. 2nd Bn reported a shell landed in their area during early part of period which caught several men sleeping on fire, gave off black smoke, came with no warning, left blackened snow in vic.
4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES -
 - a. Resist attack of this Regt from positions as shown on overlay.
 - b. Possible counter attack with remaining elements 157 Div (1 Bn 339 Regt + 315 Regt as listed in OB Regt Sect Dec 44 identified on Regt front, remaining elements of 5th Para + 1st SS Pz Div).
