- a. See overlay for known positions at start of our attack. Present line not definitely located.
 - b. Fire tremehes defended by infantry.
 - c. 1st & 2d Co 38th SS Panzer Gren Regt. 7th Co 37th SS Panzer Regt. 1st Co Engr Bn 17th SS Div.
 - d. Arty fire scattered and light.
 - e. Remaining strength of 38th Regt plus uncommitted portions of 37th Regt available as reserve.
 - f. Trains for 7th Go 37th Regt are at Gross Bliedersdorf, 5 km N of Sarreguemines.
- 2. a. Enemy in defensive position were completely surprised by our attack this morning. Resistance consequently was very light.
 - b. 1 AT gun known to have moved E toward Guebenhausen several days ago.
 Arty fire mostly morter and lob during the last 24 hours.
 - e. Engr mission to demolish bridges over AT ditches and creter roads.
 2 Oos of Engr Bn 17th Pz Gren Div committedes infantry. Pws did not know locations of mines.
- 3. a. Estimated casualties 50.
 - b. Morale not high.
 - c. Short equipment and heavy weapons.
 - d. Surprise achieved this morning indicates CI was satisfactory.
 - e. Rain and wind, old and visibility medium.
 - f. Report from prisoner interviewed by let Bn indicated most of the artillegy had been pulled back near the Saar River.
 - g. A direct hit by bomb on let Bn Hq 38th Regt killed or severely wounded 37 of 40 men including En CO and Staff.
 - h. Capabilities undetermined at this time.
