Emphasis was placed on the fact that Personnel Records are a command responsibility and all commanders are responsible that they are kept in proper order. There is no change in promotions and they may be made if vacancies exist. The Daily S-1 report is no longer necessary. Emphasis is to be placed on discipline, maintenance and cleanliness. All military personnel are prohibited to purchase civilian food. This has been emphasized in all publications from all Hq. The garrison cap is worn with the service uniform when not in formation. The area that we are occupying at the present time is the area in which General Bon Rundstedt massed his troops prior to the December 17th offensive. Most of the security threats have been taken from the area but it is estimated that in the present Div area there are approximately 1,000 such security threats remaining. Every effort is to be made to round up these people. The MG setup at Koblenz was not satisfactory for several reasons and all of the MG personnel assigned to the Div at present are in the middle of reorganization and getting setup for operation. As a result of that situation, there are perhaps a number of so-called security threats in responsible civilian positions. These will be removed when found. MG teams are available through Division. 			<p>There is an acute shortage of K and C rations. No more of these rations will be shipped to this theatre and it is very difficult to obtain any of these rations. You are to use every means possible to provide lunches for all people who need them from the regular ration. Only one reserve ration is to be kept on hand. Forms are required for all billets. Cots will be drawn when available. You are permitted to hire civilian help when it is necessary. Allied civilians are to be hired first and Germans second. Request for hiring of civilians must come through this Hq and be approved by G-4. You can not feed German or Allied workers from the regular A ration. There is a special ration for Allied workers and the Germans must be fed by the Bürgermeister. The Chief of Staff has said the Provisional MP Battalion will be dissolved on 10 Jun 45 and each Regt will orgn a Provisional Bn of its own to consist of the AT Co plus the MP's to form one MP Co. Helmets will be painted as prescribed. Each Bn will organize a MP Platoon for its area to consist of the Bn organic AT plat. These helmets will also be painted. There will be more information as to the mission of these people come down from Major Briggs. There is specialized equipment in our area (American Tks etc). We do not know if or where there is any more but we are ordered to be on the lookout for such US property and place the proper guard on it when discovered. All these things will be made available for use throughout the Division. Three days ago there was a meeting held at Corps Hq at which time they turned over considerable responsibility of administration to civilians and that plan is to continue giving them more and more responsibility as far as they are able to administer. We are directed to give the civilians the maximum help and supervision. They can use our telephones but the calls must be monitored. The so-called "small fry" Nazis are to be permitted to work if necessary. They are the more intelligent and the skilled people and if you need them to operate a railroad station or communications, they are to be permitted to work. We are back to peace-time standards, dress and discipline. Each orgn will furnish this Hq with the number of Regtl Crests desired and we will try and get them if possible. It is a command responsibility to see that all orders are being complied with. Vehicle maintenance will be emphasized. All unit identifications will be repainted on all vehicles. Any time we wish to use a hard ration, that is K's and C's we must have the approval of G-4. If you have occasion to use such rations for more than one meal a day, the first meal will be a sack lunch made up from the "A" ration. Lt Miller, Serv Co, will leave tomorrow morning for Soissons, France to assist in setting out the officers footlockers and these will be brought to us at a later date. No Off or EM is permitted to lv Germany except on</p>

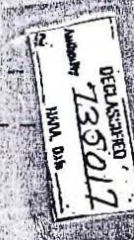
